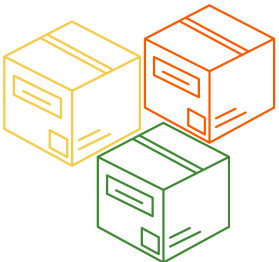
# *Executive* SUMMARY

**Engaged 10 volunteers** to support our efforts, contributing their time and energy to help achieve our mission

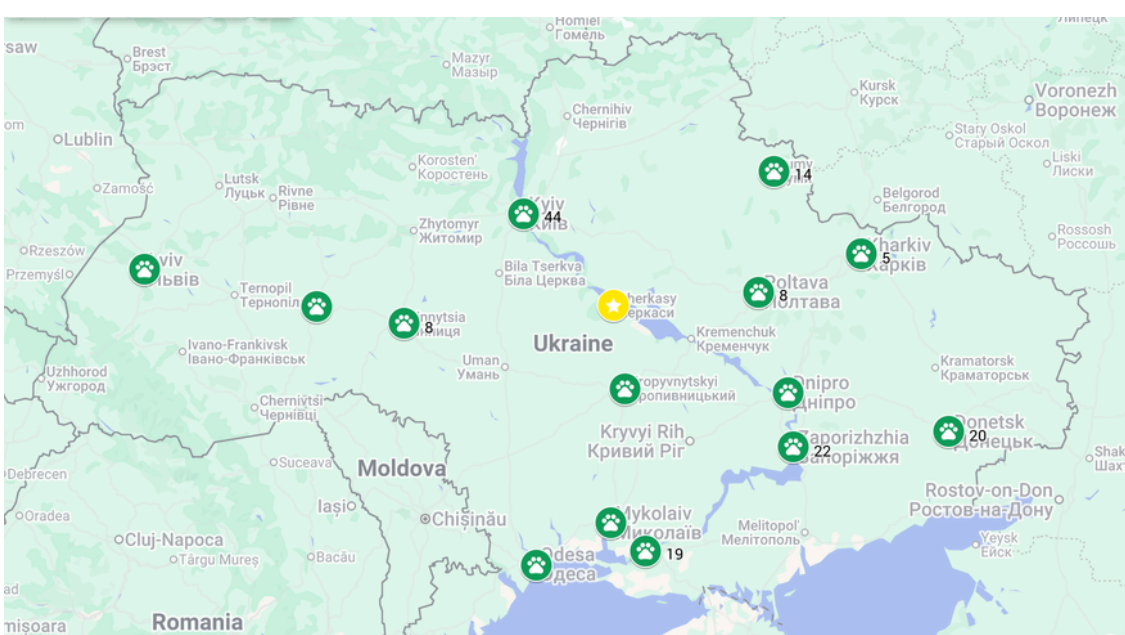


# *Impact overview*

# AID SENT

In January 2026, our volunteers prepared approximately **2,000 kg** of aid for animals in need, based on incoming requests.

# *Future plans*

Paws of Peace will continue its activities focused on:

- **Providing aid to animals** in need across Ukraine, including frontline and heavily affected regions;
- **Processing incoming requests** and supporting both new and ongoing cases;
- **Collecting and preparing aid** for upcoming shipments;
- **Supporting ongoing initiatives**, including volunteer-led projects such as *camouflage net making*;
- **Engaging with donors, partners, and supporters**, and remaining open to both individual and large-scale contributions.

We are currently preparing a **large shipment scheduled for late February – early March**, which will be delivered by truck with the support of our partners.

In February, we will also **hold our annual board meeting**, bringing together members to review the past year, elect a new board, and define the next steps for Paws of Peace.

**Our mission remains unchanged: helping animals survive, recover, and have a chance for a better life.**
