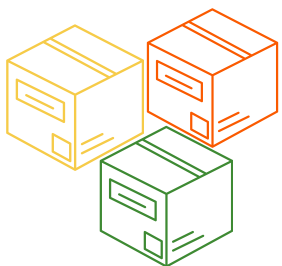
# *Executive* SUMMARY



We received **14 requests** for assistance in January

**Engaged 23 volunteers** to support our efforts, contributing their time and energy to help achieve our mission

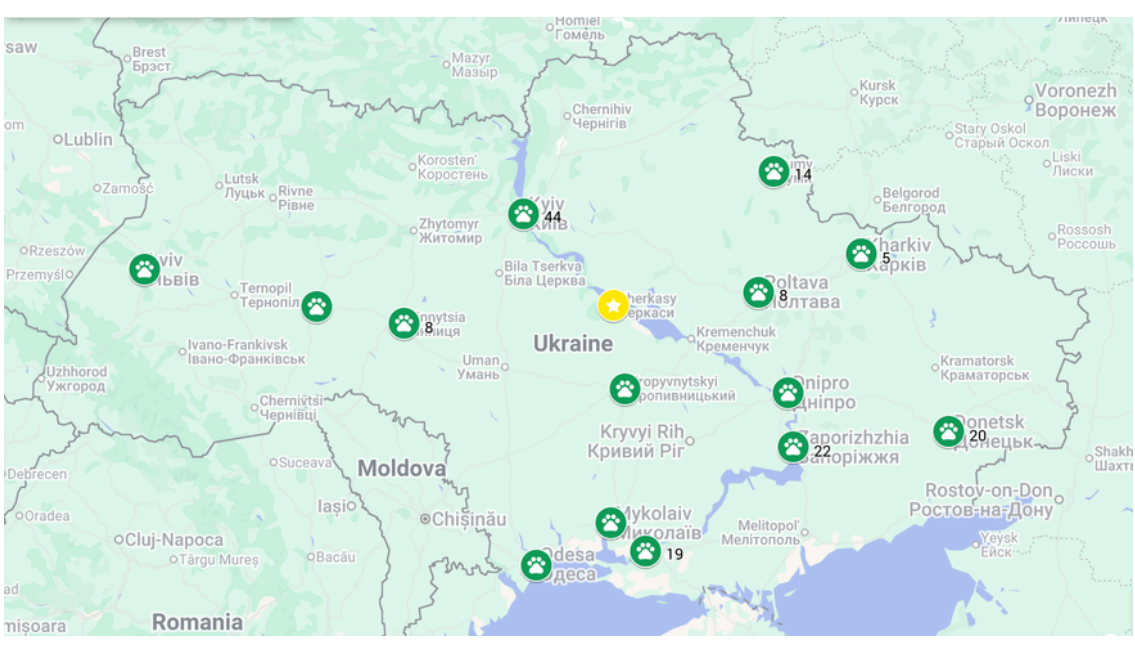


# Impact overview

# AID SENT

In February 2026, approximately **6,500 kg of aid** for animals in need was prepared in response to incoming requests.

Thanks to a partner, a truck has been provided to transport a large shipment of aid, ***scheduled for delivery to Ukraine on March 1.***

# *Future plans*

In February, several key activities are planned:

- **A large-scale shipment is scheduled** for March 1. Aid collected over the past two months will be delivered to Ukraine and distributed based on processed requests. A detailed shipment report will be presented, including an interactive map of aid distribution across regions.
- Paws of Peace **will be represented at an exhibition at Arsenalen**, increasing visibility and awareness of our work.
- Preparations continue for public engagements and **speaking opportunities** during demonstrations, advocating for animal welfare in the context of the war in Ukraine.

Ongoing activities include:

- **Providing aid to animals in need across Ukraine**, including frontline and heavily affected regions;
- **Processing incoming requests and supporting** both new and ongoing cases;
- **Collecting and coordinating aid** deliveries based on identified needs;
- **Engaging with donors, partners, and supporters to strengthen collaboration.**

**Paws of Peace remains committed to supporting animals in Ukraine and ensuring access to essential food and basic care.**
